## 1.Please Read Prior to Use

## 2. Specified Conditions of Use

Pressure Cleaning Gun is a handy tool which can be used to direct high pressure water streams/ jets for cleaning surfaces and for numerous other purposes.

#### 3. Safety Instructions

Protect yourself and your environment by taking suitable precautions so as to avoid accidents.

- Do not use the Pressure Cleaning Gun for any other purpose that it is not intended for.
- Ensure good ventilation of the work area.
- Wear protective clothing, especially safety glasses and gloves.
- Do not exceed the maximum working pressure.

- Never direct the Pressure Cleaning Gun towards /against other human beings or animals.
- Keep out of children's reach.
- Connect to high pressure pump with suitable hose.
- Water flow can be set by means of a filter/ flow control knob.
- Disconnect from water source before servicing.

# 4. Initial Operation

- Connect Pressure Cleaning Gun to a suitable pressure pump. Use a flexible hose fitted with a hose coupling.
- 2. Start operation by adjusting flow control knob
- 3. The high pressure water jet is directed onto the desired surface for cleaning.
